



2006 Summer Fun Mystery: For the Dogs Designed by Sandy Harris

Part 10: Sashing and Cornerstones

Cut:

Medium green: 12 strips 1.5" x 12.5"

Light neutral: 4 squares 1.5" x 1.5"

Step 1: Decide how you want to arrange your 9 blocks. The diagram at right shows the arrangement I chose, but you might find another way is more pleasing to you. When satisfied with your chosen arrangement, pin a small piece of paper to each block and number them 1-9. Note: my arrangement numbers are not the same as the lesson numbers.



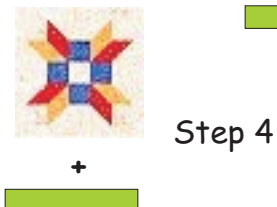
Step 2: Sew a medium green strip to the right-hand side of the blocks you numbered 1, 2, 4, 5, 7 and 8. Press seams toward the green sashing.



Step 3: Sew a light neutral square to 4 of the medium green strips. Press seams toward the green sashing. Sew these units to the bottom side of the blocks you numbered 1, 2, 4 and 5.



Step 4: Sew the remaining 2 strips to the bottom side of the blocks you numbered 3 and 6.



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Step 5: Sew the blocks for the top row together. These are the blocks you labeled 1, 2 and 3. Press new seams in direction shown by arrows.

Toward center

Step 6: Sew the blocks for the middle row together. These are the blocks you labeled 4, 5 and 6. Press new seams in direction shown by arrows.



← →
Away from center

Step 7: Sew the blocks for the bottom row together. These are the blocks you labeled 7, 8 and 9. Press new seams in direction shown by arrows.



→ ←
Toward center

Step 8: Sew the top row to the middle row. Press seam in direction of your choice.

Step 9: Sew the bottom row to the middle row. Press seam in the direction of your choice.
