**Block 5: Farmer's Daughter in the Cabin**

**Methods:** Piecing

**Colors needed:** Gold, Red, Blue, Lt. Neutral

**Tools needed:** rotary cutter and mat

**Cut:**

- Gold: 4 squares 3" x 3"
- Red: 4 squares 3" x 3"
- Blue: 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"
- Lt. Neutral: 4 squares 3" x 3"
- 9 squares 2.5" x 2.5"
- 1 rectangle 1.5" x 10.5"
- 2 rectangles 1.5" x 11.5"
- 1 rectangle 1.5" x 12.5"

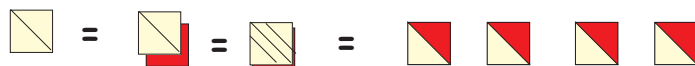
**Piecing**

1. Draw a diagonal line across back side of each 3" gold square. 

2. Pin a 3" gold square to two 3" red squares and two 3" light neutral squares. Sew 1/4" from each side of diagonal lines. Cut on drawn lines. Press open to make eight half-square triangle units.



3. Draw a diagonal line across the back side of the two remaining light neutral squares. Pin them to the remaining red squares and repeat Step 4 to make four half-square triangles. Trim all half-square triangle units to measure 2.5" square.



4. Sew Row 1 together following diagram below. Press seams in direction of arrows.



5. Sew Row 2 together following diagram below. Press seams in direction of arrows.

### Piecing, continued

6. For Row 3, sew two blue and three light neutral 2.5" squares together as shown below. Press seams toward blue squares.



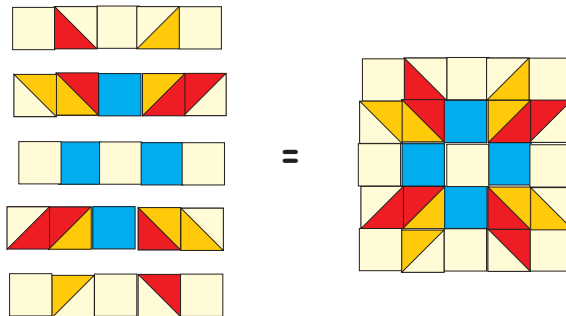
7. Sew Row 4 together following diagram below. Press seams in direction of arrows.



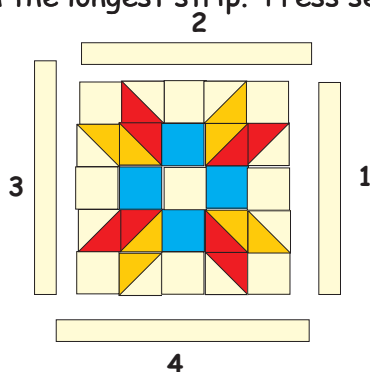
8. Sew Row 5 together following diagram below. Press seams in direction of arrows.



9. Sew rows together following the diagram below. Press seams. Trim to measure 10.5" square.



10. Sew light neutral strips to block log cabin style, beginning with the shortest strip and ending with the longest strip. Press seams after each round.



10. Press block. Square up to measure 12.5" x 12.5". Your block should look similar to the one shown here:



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
